

BAY OF THE BONES / MONASTERY OF ST. NAUM

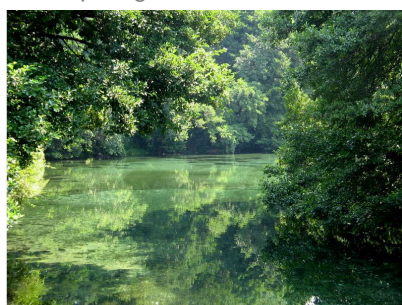
(4 HOURS TOUR)



Organized transfer from the hotel to the Bay of the Bones, a museum on water, i.e. a pre-historic lake dwelling settlement, which is a replica of a Neolithic settlement revealed with sub-aquatic archaeology. After the sightseeing of the lake dwelling settlement, the group continues to the Monastery of St. Naum. The



monastery complex lies on rocks, surrounded by the wonderful nature comprised of the springs of the river Crn Drim which flows into the Lake of Ohrid, creating astonishing landscape. The



whole place is specific for the biggest springs on the Ohrid coast, the clean water and the wonderful nature. The base of the church of St. Naum dates from the 10th century, built by the eponymous monk and miracle maker, St. Naum, healed people. The tomb of St. Naum is in the church, in a special chamber, which has many fresco paintings that speak for his acts. It's believed that if you put an ear on the tomb of St. Naum you will hear his heart beating.



After the sightseeing of the monastery, the group has the opportunity to have a kajche (small boat) experience at the springs.
